Prospective Preps are invited to meet our current Preps and join in with Friendship time. Kinder students can stay for lunch and have a play on our playgrounds. They will take part in Literacy and Numeracy games and Mrs Guy will include some of our specialist's program where possible. These include ART, PE, Science and Library. We will also have an opportunity to visit our canteen to buy a yummy treat. (If they would like to bring \$1 or \$2 that would be great). Don't forget to pack your lunch and a wide brim hat. Parents do not need to stay.

Kinder Teachers and Parents please note - We are offering two dates for the same experience so that we can cater for all groups and all Kindergartens to attend. If you would like to attend both days you are more than welcome also. We will accommodate your child's needs as best we can.

Transition dates for prospective Preps of Bunyip Primary School.

We invite our prospective Prep students to a weekly transition program. Each Thursday afternoon, Kinder students are invited to join in with Literacy and Numeracy games, building friendships with the current Year 5 students as prospective buddies in 2023.

The times are as follows:

Session 1 - Thursday 10 th of November	2:30 – 3:30pm. (parents are not required to stay)
Session 2 – Thursday 17 th of November	2:30 – 3:30pm. (parents are not required to stay)
Session 3 – Thursday 24 th of November	2:30 – 3:30pm. (parents are not required to stay)
Session 4 – Thursday 1 st of December	2:30 – 3:30pm. (parents are not required to stay)
Session 5 - Thursday 8 th of December	2:30 – 3:30pm. (parents are not required to stay)



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Tuesday 13th December 9:00 – 3:15pm State Wide Transition Day

This State Wide Transition Day is to prepare your child for a full day of learning and fun experiences in preparation for 2023. Parents are required to stay but are welcomed back at 2:30 for an afternoon tea. They can choose to arrive in their kinder uniform or casual clothes. We ask they pack a drink bottle, wide brimmed hat and snack and lunch. We will meet you in our hall at 9am.

We acknowledge that this time allocation has been increased from our previous information we sent out to families. We feel that this longer day will give your child the very best start for 2023 and will be a great way to settle little minds and reassure any anxieties your child may have.

We would also like to invite our prospective parents to an afternoon tea and Information Session to begin at 2:30 and will run till 3:15. Here you will be able to ask any questions you may have, hear what class your child will be in for 2023 and be given an opportunity to buy or try on some school uniform options.
