Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to invite your child to take part in our valuable Foundation Transition Program. During each session your child will become familiar with our school, the classrooms and the current Foundation teachers.

Arriving for transition

On arrival please make your way to the Library. If you're unsure where this is, please go to the main office. Please sign your child in when you drop them off and then sign them out at the end of each session. Please ensure you let the teachers know if someone different is collecting your child.

Important medical information

If your child has a medical condition or medication (e.g. asthma puffer, epipen) please make sure you have filled out a medical action plan form and bring the medication to each session. There was a copy of this inside the enrolment pack, alternatively please contact our office for another copy.

Students with additional needs

We welcome families of students with additional needs to contact Amie Parker our Leading Teacher (Wellbeing) to discuss how we can best support you and your family in the transition into school life at Bunyip Primary School. Please contact the school office to make an appointment.

Information Sessions

During the transition sessions there will be a series of Information Sessions for parents and carers. These sessions will run while your child is in the classroom. We hope that you can stay and listen to this valuable information each week. Tea, coffee and afternoon tea will be provided.
